S.B. No. 2265

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to an adjustment of the average daily attendance of a
3 school district with a high percentage of educationally
4 disadvantaged students.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 48.005, Education Code, is amended by
7 adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows:

8 (a-2) Notwithstanding any other adjustment to average daily
9 attendance to which a school district may be entitled under this
10 section, if the percentage of educationally disadvantaged students
11 enrolled in a school district for a school year exceeds the state
12 average percentage of educationally disadvantaged students
13 enrolled in school districts for that school year, the commissioner
14 shall adjust the district's average daily attendance for that
15 school year by multiplying the district's average daily attendance
16 by an amount, if that amount is greater than one, equal to the
17 quotient of the state average student attendance rate and the
18 district's student attendance rate. For purposes of this
19 subsection, a district's student attendance rate is the quotient of
20 the sum of attendance by students in membership for purposes of
21 average daily attendance for each day of the minimum number of days
22 of instruction as described under Section 25.081(a) divided by the
23 sum of the number of days of the minimum number of days of
24 instruction for which those students are in membership.

1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
