- INTERVIEW OF CHILD. (a) A peace officer may not conduct an 8
- 9 interview with or otherwise question a child who is younger than 12
- years of age for any purpose unless the peace officer has first 10
- obtained the consent of the child's parent or legal guardian. 11
- 12 (b) Notwithstanding Section 51.095, Family Code, a
- statement obtained in violation of this article is not admissible 13
- 14 as evidence in any proceeding concerning the matter about which the
- statement was given. 15
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 16
- to an interview or other questioning that occurs on or after the 17
- effective date of this Act. An interview or other questioning that 18
- occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law 19
- 20 in effect on the date the interview or other questioning occurred,
- 21 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
