- Sec. 56.111. CONTROL AND REPAIR OF DISTRICT IMPROVEMENTS. 6
- (a) The board may control and supervise the construction and 7
- maintenance of canals, drains, ditches and levees, and other 8
- improvements of the district and shall keep them in repair. 9
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a district described by
- this subsection may control, supervise, finance, purchase, 11
- construct, acquire, own, operate, maintain, repair, improve, and 12
- extend inside and outside its boundaries any works, improvements, 13
- facilities, plants, equipment, and appliances necessary to 14
- 15 accomplish the creation and operation of a stormwater reclamation
- system and may issue related bonds. This subsection applies only to 16
- 17 a district located in a county that is located adjacent to the
- United Mexican States, has a population of more than 800,000, and 18
- contains at least two municipalities each of which has a population 19
- of 70,000 or more. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as 22
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23
