## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.0421, Human Resources Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (c-1) The minimum training standards prescribed by the
- 8 executive commissioner under Section 42.042(p) must require an
- 9 employee, director, or operator of a child-care facility or family
- 10 home that provides care for children younger than five years of age
- 11 to complete a training program regarding trauma-informed care and
- 12 the effect of trauma on children at least once every three years.
- 13 The training may be included as a component of any other training
- 14 required by this section.
- 15 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 16 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 17 Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to implement
- 18 the changes in law made by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
