- 1 (7) provide that all pets except <u>service</u> [Seeing Eye]
 2 dogs are not permitted in the Capitol, and shall be restrained at
 3 all times on a leash or similar device in the immediate control of
 4 the owner while on the grounds of the Capitol, except as approved by
 5 the board;
- 6 (8) prohibit the use of skateboards, rollerblades, and 7 rollerskates in the Capitol or on the grounds of the Capitol; and
- 8 (9) prohibit a vendor or commercial enterprise from 9 operating in the Capitol or on the grounds of the Capitol unless the 10 vendor or commercial enterprise is authorized to do so by the board.
- SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date of this Act, the State Preservation Board shall update the rules required by Section 443.018, Government Code, as amended by this Act.
