A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to establishing an advisory board to study surface water
- 3 and groundwater interaction.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "advisory board" means
- 6 the Surface Water and Groundwater Interaction Advisory Board.
- 7 SECTION 2. SURFACE WATER AND GROUNDWATER INTERACTION
- 8 ADVISORY BOARD ESTABLISHED. (a) The Surface Water and Groundwater
- 9 Interaction Advisory Board is established and consists of 12
- 10 persons as follows:
- 11 (1) the executive administrator of the Texas Water
- 12 Development Board;
- 13 (2) one person to represent the interests of the Texas
- 14 Commission on Environmental Quality, recommended by the Texas
- 15 Commission on Environmental Quality and appointed jointly by the
- 16 chairs of the house natural resources committee and the senate
- 17 water and rural affairs committee;
- 18 (3) two persons to represent the interests of river
- 19 authorities, recommended jointly by the Texas Commission on
- 20 Environmental Quality and the Texas Water Development Board and
- 21 appointed jointly by the chairs of the house natural resources
- 22 committee and the senate water and rural affairs committee;
- 23 (4) two persons to represent the interests of
- 24 groundwater conservation districts, recommended jointly by the

- 1 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and the Texas Water
- 2 Development Board and appointed jointly by the chairs of the house
- 3 natural resources committee and the senate water and rural affairs
- 4 committee;
- 5 (5) two persons with academic or specialist knowledge
- 6 in the area of surface water and groundwater interaction, with one
- 7 appointed by the chair of the house natural resources committee and
- 8 another appointed by the chair of the senate water and rural affairs
- 9 committee;
- 10 (6) one person to represent environmental interests or
- 11 the interests relating to the interaction of surface water and
- 12 groundwater, recommended jointly by the Texas Commission on
- 13 Environmental Quality and the Texas Water Development Board and
- 14 appointed jointly by the chairs of the house natural resources
- 15 committee and the senate water and rural affairs committee;
- 16 (7) the chair of the house natural resources
- 17 committee;
- 18 (8) the chair of the senate water and rural affairs
- 19 committee; and
- 20 (9) one person from the office of the governor,
- 21 appointed by the governor.
- 22 (b) The executive administrator of the Texas Water
- 23 Development Board serves as the chair of the advisory board.
- SECTION 3. PUBLIC MEETING. The advisory board shall hold at
- 25 least one public meeting in order to accept comments from the public
- 26 on matters studied by the advisory board.
- 27 SECTION 4. SURFACE WATER AND GROUNDWATER INTERACTION STUDY.

- 1 (a) The advisory board shall study:
- 2 (1) the extent to which surface water and groundwater
- 3 interact in this state;
- 4 (2) challenges arising in this state from the
- 5 interaction of surface water and groundwater; and
- 6 (3) approaches to mitigating challenges arising in
- 7 this state from the interaction of surface water and groundwater.
- 8 (b) In conducting the study under this section, the advisory
- 9 board shall consult with:
- 10 (1) the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;
- 11 (2) groundwater conservation districts; and
- 12 (3) river authorities.
- 13 SECTION 5. STUDY REPORT; EXPIRATION OF ACT. (a) The
- 14 advisory board shall deliver to the governor, the lieutenant
- 15 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and each
- 16 member of the legislature a report on the determinations of the
- 17 advisory board based on the study conducted under Section 4 of this
- 18 Act not later than December 1, 2024. The advisory board shall
- 19 deliver to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of
- 20 the house of representatives, or a member of the legislature
- 21 related information on request.
- 22 (b) The advisory board is abolished and this Act expires
- 23 January 1, 2025.
- 24 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 25 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 26 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 27 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for

1 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
