1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the division of certain emergency services districts.  
1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-23 SECTION 1. Section [775.221\(a\)](#), Health and Safety Code, is  
1-24 amended to read as follows:  
1-25 (a) This subchapter applies only to a district located  
1-26 wholly in:  
1-27 (1) a county with a population of 20,000 or less; [~~or~~]  
1-28 (2) a county with a population of more than 30,000 but  
1-29 less than 41,000 that is adjacent to a county with a population of  
1-30 more than 200,000 but less than 220,000; or  
1-31 (3) a county with a population of more than 150,000 and  
1-32 less than 164,000.  
1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
