1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the development of a webpage and mobile application for  
 1-22 the provision of pregnancy-related resources and information.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 161, Health and Safety Code, is amended  
 1-25 by adding Subchapter X to read as follows:

1-26 SUBCHAPTER X. PREGNANCY-RELATED RESOURCES AND INFORMATION

1-27 Sec. 161.701. PREGNANCY-RELATED RESOURCES AND INFORMATION  
 1-28 WEBPAGE. (a) The commission, with assistance from the Department  
 1-29 of Information Resources, shall develop and maintain on the  
 1-30 Texas.gov Internet website a publicly accessible, mobile-friendly  
 1-31 webpage of pregnancy-related resources and information, including  
 1-32 any available:

1-33 (1) resources for:

1-34 (A) mental health counseling, pregnancy  
 1-35 counseling, and other prenatal and postpartum services;

1-36 (B) mentorship opportunities, including  
 1-37 pregnancy assistance and case management;

1-38 (C) health care and well-being services,  
 1-39 including services for obstetrical and gynecological support,  
 1-40 abortion pill reversal, breast-feeding assistance, health care,  
 1-41 and dental care;

1-42 (D) financial assistance, employment  
 1-43 opportunities, nutrition assistance, child care options, and  
 1-44 educational opportunities;

1-45 (E) legal services, including legal services for  
 1-46 child support, custody issues, family leave, and breast-feeding  
 1-47 protections;

1-48 (F) professional support, including tax  
 1-49 preparation;

1-50 (G) financial and housing assistance, including  
 1-51 assistance with food, nutrition, clothing, household goods, baby  
 1-52 supplies, housing options, shelter options, maternity home  
 1-53 options, and crisis pregnancy center options;

1-54 (H) recovery and mental health services,  
 1-55 including services for addiction or suicide intervention,  
 1-56 counseling services for victims of intimate partner violence,  
 1-57 sexual assault, or sex trafficking, and counseling services for the  
 1-58 unexpected loss of a child;

1-59 (I) prenatal diagnostic services and postnatal  
 1-60 pediatric hospice services, including newborn medical

2-1 interventions and supportive palliative care, and disability  
2-2 support organizations;  
2-3 (J) healing and support services for abortion  
2-4 survivors and the survivors' families; and  
2-5 (K) services related to providing care for  
2-6 children, including services for public and private adoption,  
2-7 foster care, and short-term child care;  
2-8 (2) information about:  
2-9 (A) alternatives to abortion;  
2-10 (B) abortion risks, including complications and  
2-11 failures;  
2-12 (C) child development beginning at conception;  
2-13 (D) pregnancy wellness;  
2-14 (E) family planning;  
2-15 (F) the Healthy Texas Women program defined by  
2-16 Section 32.151;  
2-17 (G) the Alternatives to Abortion program  
2-18 administered by the commission; and  
2-19 (H) any pregnancy-related services provided by a  
2-20 county in this state; and  
2-21 (3) any other resources or information considered  
2-22 helpful to pregnant women.  
2-23 (b) The webpage described by Subsection (a) must:  
2-24 (1) through a series of questions, provide the person  
2-25 accessing the webpage information tailored to the person's answers,  
2-26 including information regarding risks related to abortion at all  
2-27 stages of gestation;  
2-28 (2) allow for webpage users to submit feedback  
2-29 regarding whether the webpage is user-friendly and helpful in  
2-30 providing tailored answers described by Subdivision (1); and  
2-31 (3) include a tool to search for resources described  
2-32 by Subsection (a) by zip code and county.  
2-33 Sec. 161.702. PREGNANCY-RELATED RESOURCES AND INFORMATION  
2-34 MOBILE APPLICATION. The commission, with assistance from the  
2-35 Department of Information Resources, may develop a mobile  
2-36 application that:  
2-37 (1) provides the resources and information described  
2-38 by Section 161.701(a); and  
2-39 (2) satisfies the requirements described by Section  
2-40 161.701(b).  
2-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
