## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the requirements for issuance of a driver's license or
3	learner license to a person younger than 18 years of age.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 521.204(a), Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The department may issue a Class C driver's license to
8	an applicant under 18 years of age only if the applicant:
9	(1) is 16 years of age or older;
10	(2) has submitted to the department a driver education
11	certificate issued under Section 1001.055, Education Code, that
12	states that the person has completed and passed a driver education
13	course approved by the Texas Department of Licensing and
14	Regulation; and
15	(3) [ <del>has obtained a high school diploma or its</del>
16	equivalent or is a student:
17	[(A) enrolled in a public school, home school, or
18	private school who attended school for at least 80 days in the fall
19	or spring semester preceding the date of the driver's license
20	application; or
21	(B) who has been enrolled for at least 45 days,
22	and is enrolled as of the date of the application, in a program to
23	prepare persons to pass the high school equivalency exam;
24	[(1) has submitted to the department written parental

- 11 SECTION 2. Section 521.222(a), Transportation Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) The department may issue a learner license, including a
- 14 Class A or Class B driver's learner license, to a person who:
- 15 (1) is 15 years of age or older but under 18 years of
- 16 age;
- 17 (2) has satisfactorily completed and passed the
- 18 classroom phase of an approved driver education course, which may
- 19 be a course taught under Section 1001.112, Education Code; and
- 20 (3) [meets the requirements imposed under Section
- 21  $\frac{521.204(a)(3)}{and}$
- [(4)] has passed each examination required under
- 23 Section 521.161 other than the driving test.
- SECTION 3. Section 521.003, Transportation Code, is
- 25 repealed.
- 26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
