- SECTION 2. Sections 87.0241(a) and (c), Election Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) The early voting ballot board shall make its
 14 determination [may determine] whether to accept early voting
 15 ballots voted by mail in accordance with Section 87.041 [at any
 16 time] after the ballots are delivered to the board.
- (c) The secretary of state shall prescribe any procedures necessary for implementing this section [in regard to elections described by Subsection (b)(2)].
