1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to required reporting regarding a school district's
 1-24 program for gifted and talented students.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
 1-27 amended by adding Section 29.124 to read as follows:

1-28 Sec. 29.124. PEIMS REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. Each school
 1-29 district shall include the following information in the district's
 1-30 Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) report:

1-31 (1) the name and contact information of the district
 1-32 administrator responsible for ensuring that the district is in
 1-33 compliance with this subchapter;

1-34 (2) whether the district uses data from an entire
 1-35 grade level to identify gifted and talented students; and

1-36 (3) if applicable, the grade levels for which the
 1-37 district identifies gifted and talented students as described by
 1-38 Subdivision (2).

1-39 SECTION 2. Section 39.306, Education Code, is amended by
 1-40 amending Subsection (d-1) and adding Subsection (d-2) to read as
 1-41 follows:

1-42 (d-1) The comparison provided by the agency under
 1-43 Subsection (d) must include a comparison of college, career, and
 1-44 military readiness achievement between students served in a program
 1-45 for gifted and talented students and students served in other
 1-46 programs.

1-47 (d-2) The report must also include the number of school
 1-48 counselors providing counseling services at each campus.

1-49 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
 1-50 school year.

1-51 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-52 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-53 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-54 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-55 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
