A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to personal information entered on the carrier envelope of
3	a ballot to be voted by mail.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 86.002, Election Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (d-1) and amending Subsection (g) to read as
7	follows:
8	(d-1) The secretary of state shall prescribe instructions
9	to be printed on the balloting materials for marking the ballot
10	envelope with the information required under Subsection (g). The
11	instructions must:
12	(1) be printed in at least a 10-point font;
13	(2) except as provided by Subdivision (3), not include
14	the text "V.U.I.D." or the words "voter registration number"; and
15	(3) contain the statement: "A voter registration
16	number (V.U.I.D.) does not satisfy the requirement to enter the
17	number of an election identification certificate and should not be
18	printed on the carrier envelope."
19	(g) The carrier envelope must include a space, at least one
20	half inch in height and two inches in width, that is hidden from
21	view when the envelope is sealed for the voter to enter the
22	following information:
23	(1) the number of the voter's driver's license,
24	election identification certificate, or personal identification

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1 card issued by the Department of Public Safety;

2 (2) if the voter has not been issued a number described 3 by Subdivision (1), the last four digits of the voter's social 4 security number; or

5 (3) a statement by the applicant that the applicant 6 has not been issued a number described by Subdivision (1) or (2).

7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
