- Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- In this section, "commission" means the SECTION 1. (a) 5
- Health and Human Services Commission.
- 7 The commission shall conduct a study regarding the
- availability of beds at inpatient mental health facilities in this 8
- state that provide acute inpatient psychiatric treatment. 9
- 10 study must evaluate:

- the current number of psychiatric beds available 11
- 12 at inpatient mental health facilities in this state that provide
- 13 inpatient psychiatric treatment to individuals experiencing an
- acute mental health crisis, including a breakdown of: 14
- 15 (i) the number of beds available for competency
- restoration; 16
- (ii) the number of beds available to patients who 17

- (iii) the number of beds available to patients 19
- who are 18 years of age or older as well as the number of beds 20
- available to patients that are 17 years of age or younger; and 21
- 22 (iv) the percentage of current patients
- 23 receiving inpatient psychiatric treatment in this state that are
- 24 likely to require long term care;

- 1 (2) the current number of patients at inpatient mental
- 2 health facilities in this state that provide inpatient psychiatric
- 3 treatment to individuals experiencing an acute mental crisis,
- 4 including a breakdown of the following:
- 5 (i) the number of patients admitted to these
- 6 facilities for competency restoration purposes;
- 7 (ii) the number of patients admitted to these
- 8 facilities as a result of a civil commitment order;
- 9 (iii) the number of patients admitted to these
- 10 facilities who are 18 years of age or older as well as the number of
- 11 patients who are 17 years of age or younger; and
- 12 (iv) the number of patients admitted to these
- 13 facilities that have been diagnosed with an intellectual or
- 14 developmental disability;
- 15 (3) the projected need over the next several years for
- 16 additional psychiatric beds at inpatient mental health facilities
- 17 that provide inpatient psychiatric treatment to those individuals,
- 18 including an estimation of the percent of incoming patients that
- 19 will require long term care; and
- 20 (4) current and anticipated resources necessary to
- 21 meet the demands described by Subdivisions (1), (2), and (3).
- (c) In designing and conducting the study, the commission
- 23 may collaborate with institutions of higher education in this state
- 24 that award medical degrees.
- 25 (d) Not later than September 1, 2024, the commission shall
- 26 prepare and submit to the legislature a written report containing
- 27 the results of the study and any recommendations for legislative or

- 1 other action.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act expires September 1, 2025.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
