4	SECTION 1. Section 4101.052, Insurance Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read
6	as follows:
7	(a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an [An] applicant
8	for a license under this chapter must submit to the department an
9	application on a form prescribed and provided by the department,
10	and include as part of or in connection with the application any
11	information that the department reasonably requires, including
12	information about the applicant's:
13	(1) identity;
14	(2) personal history;
15	(3) experience; and
16	(4) business record.
17	(c) For the purpose of Subsection (a), the commissioner
18	shall allow an individual to apply for a license electronically
19	using the National Association of Insurance Commissioners Uniform
20	Application for Individual Adjuster or Apprentice
21	License/Registration as it existed on May 1, 2023.
22	(d) The commissioner shall take any action necessary for
23	this state to participate in and adopt the application procedures
24	of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners National

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- 1 Insurance Producer Registry for the purpose of licensing and
- 2 <u>license renewal for independent adjusters.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2024, the
- 4 commissioner of insurance shall adopt rules to implement Section
- 5 4101.052(d), Insurance Code, as added by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
