1-22 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-23 AN ACT

1-24 relating to a survey of public schools regarding Holocaust
 1-25 Remembrance Week instruction.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Subchapter 2, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
 1-28 amended by adding Section 29.90725 to read as follows:

1-29 Sec. 29.90725. SURVEY ON HOLOCAUST REMEMBRANCE WEEK
 1-30 INSTRUCTION. (a) In this section, "advisory commission" means the
 1-31 Texas Holocaust, Genocide, and Antisemitism Advisory Commission.

1-32 (b) The advisory commission, with the assistance of the
 1-33 agency, shall conduct a survey of school districts to review the
 1-34 implementation at each district of Holocaust Remembrance Week
 1-35 instruction under Section 29.9072.

1-36 (c) The survey must request information from at least half
 1-37 of the campuses in a surveyed school district regarding Holocaust
 1-38 Remembrance Week instruction, including:

1-39 (1) the extent to which the campus participates in
 1-40 Holocaust Remembrance Week;

1-41 (2) the familiarity of the educators and
 1-42 administrators at each campus with the materials and resources
 1-43 available from the advisory commission and other local institutions
 1-44 dedicated to Holocaust education to support instruction during
 1-45 Holocaust Remembrance Week; and

1-46 (3) any additional materials or resources the campus
 1-47 would find useful to support instruction during Holocaust
 1-48 Remembrance Week, including professional development for
 1-49 educators, lessons plans, or other classroom resources.

1-50 (d) Not later than December 1, 2024, the advisory commission
 1-51 shall submit to the legislature a written report that includes the
 1-52 survey's findings and any recommendations for legislative or other
 1-53 action.

1-54 (e) This section expires September 1, 2025.

1-55 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
