4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 352, Labor Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter D to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER D. CULTURAL ADVANCEMENT WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT FUND
8	Sec.353.201. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Commission" means the Texas Workforce
10	Commission.
11	(2) "Cultural advancement" means any efforts that
12	promote and support the sustainability of any culture in the State
13	of Texas, including a culture's art, dance, music, or history.
14	(a) For purposes of this section, "culture" means
15	any nationality, racial, or ethnic group.
16	(3) "Fund" means the cultural advancement fund created
17	under Section 353.202.
18	Sec. 352.202. CULTURAL ADVANCEMENT FUND. (a) The
19	commission shall establish and administer the Cultural Advancement
20	Workforce Development Fund as a dedicated account in the general
21	revenue fund.
22	(b) The following amounts shall be deposited in the
23	fund:
24	(1) any money appropriated by the legislature for

- 1 the fund for purposes of this chapter;
- 2 (2) interest earned on the investment of money in
- 3 the fund; and
- 4 (3) gifts, grants, and donations received for the
- 5 fund.
- 6 Sec. 352.203. GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The commission shall
- 7 establish and administer the Cultural Advancement Workforce
- 8 Development Fund grant program to benefit nonprofit corporations
- 9 defined by section 22.001, Business Organizations Code or other
- 10 entities that spur economic development or advances workforce
- 11 development through cultural advancement.
- 12 (b) To be eligible to receive a grant under the grant
- 13 program, an applicant must:
- 14 (1) apply in a manner prescribed by commission rule;
- 15 (2) be in good standing under the laws of this state;
- 16 and
- 17 (3) have a legitimate need for the grant.
- Sec.352.204. USES OF GRANT. A grant recipient may use the
- 19 grant received under this subchapter for any expense needed to
- 20 promote workforce development, including costs related to payroll,
- 21 programming, remodeling, and renovating facilities.
- 22 <u>Sec. 252.205. RULES. The commission shall adopt rules</u>
- 23 <u>necessary to implement this subchapter.</u>
- 24 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 25 of this Act, and not later than September 1, 2024, the Texas
- 26 Workforce Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 27 Subchapter D, Chapter 352, Labor Code, as added by this Act.
