4	providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose
5	fees and taxes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
8	Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7970A to read as follows:
9	CHAPTER 7970A. MONTGOMERY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT
10	NO. 229
11	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
12	Sec. 7970A.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
13	(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.
14	(2) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on
15	Environmental Quality.
16	(3) "Director" means a board member.
17	(4) "District" means the Montgomery County Municipal
18	Utility District No. 229.
19	Sec. 7970A.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a
20	municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI,
21	Texas Constitution.
22	Sec. 7970A.0103. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTORS' ELECTION
23	REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to
24	confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent

1 directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

Sec. 7970A.0104. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The temporary directors may not hold an election under Section 7970A.0103 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the district and to the inclusion of land in the district.

Sec. 7970A.0105. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. 8 9 (a) The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit. (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of: 10 11 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and 12 13 (2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation, 14 or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or 15 16 improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads. 17 Sec. 7970A.0106. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The

18 <u>district is initially composed of the territory described by</u>
19 <u>Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.</u>

20 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of 21 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the 22 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process 23 does not affect the district's:

(1) organization, existence, or validity;

25 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
26 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
27 interest on a bond;

1 (3) right to impose a tax; or 2 (4) legality or operation. SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS 3 Sec. 7970A.0201. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district 4 is governed by a board of five elected directors. 5 6 (b) Except as provided by Section 7970A.0202, directors 7 serve staggered four-year terms. Sec. 7970A.0202. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after 8 9 September 1, 2023, the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to 10 the commission requesting that the commission appoint as temporary 11 directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission 12 13 shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons named in the 14 petition. 15 (b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of: 16 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under 17 Section 7970A.0103; or 18 (2) September 1, 2027. (c) If permanent directors have not been elected under 19 20 Section 7970A.0103 and the terms of the temporary directors have expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or 21 reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that 22 23 expire on the earlier of: 24 (1) the date permanent directors are elected under 25 Section 7970A.0103; or 26 (2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the 27 appointment or reappointment.

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1 (d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a 2 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district 3 may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the 4 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five 5 persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as 6 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the 7 petition.

SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

9 <u>Sec. 7970A.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district</u> 10 <u>has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for</u> 11 <u>which the district is created.</u>

Sec. 7970A.0302. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

Sec. 7970A.0303. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. Under 17 Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may 18 design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, 19 operate, maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a 20 21 municipality for operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or improvements, including storm drainage, in aid 22 23 of those roads. Sec. 7970A.0304. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A 24 road project must meet all applicable construction standards, 25

26 <u>zoning and subdivision requirements</u>, and regulations of each 27 <u>municipality</u> in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial

jurisdiction the road project is located. 1 2 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits 3 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road project must meet all applicable construction standards, 4 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which 5 6 the road project is located. 7 (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the 8 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and specifications of the road project. 9 Sec. 7970A.0305. COMPLIANCE WITH 10 MUNICIPAL CONSENT

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11 ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all applicable requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is 12 13 adopted under Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that 14 consents to the creation of the district or to the inclusion of land in the district. 15 16 Sec. 7970A.0306. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district 17 may be divided into two or more new districts only if the district: 18 (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes. 19 20 (b) This chapter applies to any new district created by the 21 division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and duties of the district. 22 23 (c) Any new district created by the division of the district may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land 24 outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act enacting this 25 26 chapter.

27 (d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition

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1	signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of
2	the real property in the district, may adopt an order dividing the
3	district.
4	(e) The board may adopt an order dividing the district
5	before or after the date the board holds an election under Section
6	7970A.0103 to confirm the district's creation.
7	(f) An order dividing the district shall:
8	(1) name each new district;
9	(2) include the metes and bounds description of the
10	territory of each new district;
11	(3) appoint temporary directors for each new district;
12	and
13	(4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities
14	between or among the new districts.
15	(g) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of
16	an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order
17	with the commission and record the order in the real property
18	records of each county in which the district is located.
19	(h) Any new district created by the division of the district
20	shall hold a confirmation and directors' election as required by
21	Section 7970A.0103. If the voters of a new district do not confirm
22	the creation of the new district, the assets, obligations,
23	territory, and governance of the new district revert to the
24	original district.
25	(i) If the creation of the new district is confirmed, the
26	new district shall provide the election date and results to the
27	commission.

1 (j) Municipal consent to the creation of the district and to 2 the inclusion of land in the district granted under Section 3 7970A.0104 acts as municipal consent to the creation of any new district created by the division of the district and to the 4 inclusion of land in the new district. 5 6 (k) Any new district created by the division of the district 7 must hold an election as required by this chapter to obtain voter approval before the district may impose a maintenance tax or issue 8 9 bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes. 10 (1) This chapter applies to any new district created by the 11 division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and 12 duties of the district. 13 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS Sec. 7970A.0401. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) 14 The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other 15 16 obligations secured by: 17 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or 18 (2) contract <u>payments</u> described by Section 19 7970A.0403. 20 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval 21 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds 22 23 payable from ad valorem taxes. 24 (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem 25 taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an 26 27 election held for that purpose.

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1	Sec. 7970A.0402. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
2	authorized at an election held under Section 7970A.0401, the
3	district may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable
4	property in the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water
5	<u>Code.</u>
6	(b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
7	exceed the rate approved at the election.
8	Sec. 7970A.0403. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with
9	Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than
10	an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from
11	the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of
12	the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters
13	voting at an election held for that purpose.
14	(b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a
15	provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by
16	the board without further voter approval.
17	SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS
18	Sec. 7970A.0501. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
19	OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations
20	payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,
21	revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any
22	combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district
23	purpose.
24	Sec. 7970A.0502. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district
25	issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the
26	board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing
27	direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all

or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner
 provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.

3 <u>Sec. 7970A.0503. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of</u> 4 <u>issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations</u> 5 <u>issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad</u> 6 <u>valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the</u> 7 <u>real property in the district.</u>

8 SECTION 2. The Montgomery County Municipal Utility District 9 No. 229 initially includes all the territory contained in the 10 following area:

20 Environmental Quality.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 21 (C) its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 22 23 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the of house 24 representatives within the required time.

(d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled

1 and accomplished.

2 SECTION 4. (a) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds 3 vote of all the members elected to each house, Subchapter C, Chapter 4 7970A, Special District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of 5 this Act, is amended by adding Section 7970A.0307 to read as 6 follows:

Sec. 7970A.0307. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

9 (b) This section is not intended to be an expression of a 10 legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c), 11 Article I, Texas Constitution.
