## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the jurisdiction of the 411th District Court and of the County Court at Law of Polk County. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 24.553, Government Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 6 7 (c) The 411th District Court has concurrent jurisdiction in Polk County with the county court over all misdemeanor cases over 8 9 which the county court has jurisdiction under the constitution and laws of this state. Cases in the concurrent misdemeanor 10 jurisdiction may be filed in either court, and all cases of 11 concurrent misdemeanor jurisdiction may be transferred between the 12 411th District Court and the county court. A case may not be 13 14 transferred from one court to another without the consent of the judge of the court to which it is transferred, and a case may not be 15 16 transferred unless it is within the jurisdiction of the court to which it is transferred. 17 SECTION 2. Sections 25.1892(a) and (e), Government Code, 18 are amended to read as follows: 19 20 In addition to the jurisdiction provided by Section (a) 25.0003 and other law, a county court at law in Polk County has 21 concurrent [civil] jurisdiction with the district court in: 22 23 (1) cases and proceedings involving the collection of delinquent taxes, penalties, interest, and costs and 24 the

foreclosure of tax liens; [and] 1 2 (2) family law cases and proceedings; and 3 (3) felony cases to conduct arraignments and pre-trial hearings and to accept guilty pleas. 4 The district clerk serves as clerk of a county court at 5 (e) law in cases of concurrent jurisdiction with the district court 6 [enumerated in Subsection (a)(2)], and the county clerk serves as 7 clerk in all other cases. [The district clerk shall establish a 8 9 separate docket for a county court at law. 10 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a case filed or proceeding commenced on or after the effective date 11 of this Act. A case filed or proceeding commenced before the 12 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 13 date the case was filed or the proceeding was commenced, and the 14 15 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 16 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
