1-21 relating to authorizing certain political subdivisions to change
 1-22 the date on which their general election for officers is held.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by
 1-25 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

1-26 (a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a municipality wholly
 1-27 or partly located in a county with a population of more than 19,900
 1-28 and less than 20,000 that holds its general election for officers on
 1-29 a date other than the November uniform election date may change the
 1-30 date on which it holds its general election for officers to the
 1-31 November uniform election date.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
