

1 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The State of Texas is home to some of the finest high
3 school coaches in the country, who are committed to helping young
4 Texans reach their full potential in their athletic endeavors and
5 build a strong foundation for future success; and

6 WHEREAS, Coaches exert a positive influence on the
7 development of young people and serve as role models during
8 students' formative years; in the course of their duties, these
9 educators teach fundamental life lessons and instill important
10 values such as discipline, integrity, respect, teamwork, and good
11 sportsmanship in young competitors; moreover, coaches help
12 establish and maintain the vibrant culture of high school sports,
13 which enriches the educational experience for all students and
14 strengthens the school's connection to the wider community; and

15 WHEREAS, The individuals who make up the state's secondary
16 school coaching ranks are supported by the Texas High School
17 Coaches Association, an advocacy and leadership organization
18 focused on furthering education and professionalism among its
19 members; formally organized in 1930 as the Texas High School
20 Football Coaches Association, the group sponsored the first
21 coaching school in San Antonio three years later; it assumed its
22 current name in 1941 after opening its doors to coaches in all
23 University Interscholastic League sports; in the decades since,
24 THSCA has grown to more than 25,000 members, making it one of the

1 largest organizations of its kind in the world; and

2 WHEREAS, Playing an integral role in secondary education, the
3 high school coaches of the Lone Star State are truly deserving of
4 recognition for the positive guidance they provide to students and
5 for furthering the state's proud tradition of athletic excellence;
6 now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the 88th Legislature of the State of Texas
8 hereby designate November 3 as Texas High School Coaches Day and
9 commend all those associated with the Texas High School Coaches
10 Association for their dedicated efforts; and, be it further

11 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section
12 [391.004\(d\)](#), Government Code, this designation remain in effect
13 until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is finally
14 passed by the legislature.
