1-17 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-18 WHEREAS, The State of Texas is home to some of the finest high  
1-19 school coaches in the country, who are committed to helping young  
1-20 Texans reach their full potential in their athletic endeavors and  
1-21 build a strong foundation for future success; and

1-22 WHEREAS, Coaches exert a positive influence on the  
1-23 development of young people and serve as role models during  
1-24 students' formative years; in the course of their duties, these  
1-25 educators teach fundamental life lessons and instill important  
1-26 values such as discipline, integrity, respect, teamwork, and good  
1-27 sportsmanship in young competitors; moreover, coaches help  
1-28 establish and maintain the vibrant culture of high school sports,  
1-29 which enriches the educational experience for all students and  
1-30 strengthens the school's connection to the wider community; and

1-31 WHEREAS, The individuals who make up the state's secondary  
1-32 school coaching ranks are supported by the Texas High School  
1-33 Coaches Association, an advocacy and leadership organization  
1-34 focused on furthering education and professionalism among its  
1-35 members; formally organized in 1930 as the Texas High School  
1-36 Football Coaches Association, the group sponsored the first  
1-37 coaching school in San Antonio three years later; it assumed its  
1-38 current name in 1941 after opening its doors to coaches in all  
1-39 University Interscholastic League sports; in the decades since,  
1-40 THSCA has grown to more than 25,000 members, making it one of the  
1-41 largest organizations of its kind in the world; and

1-42 WHEREAS, Playing an integral role in secondary education, the  
1-43 high school coaches of the Lone Star State are truly deserving of  
1-44 recognition for the positive guidance they provide to students and  
1-45 for furthering the state's proud tradition of athletic excellence;  
1-46 now, therefore, be it

1-47 RESOLVED, That the 88th Legislature of the State of Texas  
1-48 hereby designate November 3 as Texas High School Coaches Day and  
1-49 commend all those associated with the Texas High School Coaches  
1-50 Association for their dedicated efforts; and, be it further

1-51 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section  
1-52 391.004(d), Government Code, this designation remain in effect  
1-53 until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is finally  
1-54 passed by the legislature.
