SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1 2 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the sorrow felt by the family and friends of Captain Charles Dwayne Krampota of the 3 4 Alvin Volunteer Fire Department, who passed away on September 23, 2022, at the age of 60; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Born on April 13, 1962, Charles Krampota was the son of Alfred and Edna Krampota; he treasured time spent with his 7 8 family, which included his parents and his son and daughter-in-law, 9 Seth and Melissa Krampota; and 10 WHEREAS, On September 23, 2022, Captain Krampota responded to a mobile home fire in Alvin; the structure was unoccupied, and he 11 12 and his fellow firefighters extinguished the blaze and cleared the 13 scene; tragically, he died at his home a few hours after the incident; this dedicated first responder served for more than two 14 15 decades with Alvin VFD, earning a reputation for his exceptional courage and work ethic over the course of his tenure; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Additionally, Mr. Krampota was employed by the Alvin Independent School District for 37 years, and he retired as 18 mechanical systems manager; among his responsibilities, he oversaw 19 daily mechanical operations at the district's campuses; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Admired for his cheerful demeanor and willingness to 22 help others, Charles Krampota lived a caring and purposeful life, and he leaves behind a record of service that his loved ones can 23
