## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to provide for legislative review and approval of state agency
- 3 rules.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article II, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 2 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2. The legislature may prescribe a process for the
- 8 legislative review of rules adopted by agencies in the executive
- 9 department for the purpose of ensuring that each agency rule is
- 10 consistent with the intent of the legislature in enacting the
- 11 statute the rule is adopted to implement, interpret, or prescribe.
- 12 The process prescribed by the legislature may provide the manner by
- 13 which the legislative review is conducted, and may allow for the
- 14 approval or rejection by the legislature of all or any part of an
- 15 adopted rule. Notwithstanding Sections 14 and 15, Article IV, of
- 16 this constitution, or any other law, the approval or rejection of
- 17 all or any part of an adopted rule by the legislature is not subject
- 18 to disapproval by the governor.
- 19 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 23 legislature to provide for legislative review and approval of state
- 24 agency rules."
