3 University Interscholastic League state championship; and

14 team's exceptional showing were Kyla Coheley, who clocked in at
15 12:23.00, Jaci Shepherd, who finished in 12:40.10, Breagan Blowers,
16 who completed the course in 12:47.10, and Briar Griffin, who posted
17 a time of 13:09.60; and

19 cross country team have distinguished themselves through their
20 skill, hard work, and enduring commitment to excellence, and they
21 will cherish their memories of their state title triumph for the
