2 and White Medical Center - Plano, has been named one of the 25
3 Outstanding Texas Nurses for 2022 by the Texas Nurses Association;

6 across the state who have distinguished themselves as resourceful
7 and innovative frontline heroes during an unprecedented public
8 health crisis while helping to ensure a culture of compassionate
9 care at the institutions they serve; and

11 in leading a clinical team initiative for the administration of
12 monoclonal infusion therapies during the COVID-19 pandemic; up to
13 50 therapies were given per day, and the hospital infusion center
14 provided more than 2,800 monoclonal treatments overall;
15 additionally, he helped set up COVID testing for pre-operative
16 patients on weekends and curbside testing for those with mobility
17 issues; and
