- 19 joined his father in the family's residential and commercial real
- 20 estate business; in 1980, he traveled with Federal Housing
- 21 Administration representatives to the Middle East to meet with
- 22 Egyptian president Anwar Sadat and other government officials about
- 23 the development of low-cost housing; and
