1 WHEREAS, Emergency medical technician Colton Thomas of the 2 Wise County Office of Emergency Management has been named the 3 recipient of a Life Saving Medal in recognition of his role in 4 providing medical assistance to two Fort Worth residents involved 5 in a vehicle accident; and

WHEREAS, On February 2, 2022, Colton Thomas responded to a 6 7 traffic incident in which a car lost control on an iced-over bridge and plunged into the Trinity River; the passenger was pulled from 8 9 the vehicle by a witness, and the driver remained trapped in the car when it sank; a Wise County swift water technician swam into the 10 11 frigid river and extracted the man from the vehicle; Mr. Thomas helped provide lifesaving assistance on the shore, and the man 12 rescued from the submerged car was transported to a hospital and is 13 14 expected to fully recover; and

15 WHEREAS, Every day, the first responders of Texas are called 16 to the aid of individuals in need, and through his swift and 17 decisive action in this critical situation, Colton Thomas upheld 18 the highest standards of his profession and helped to save the life 19 of a fellow citizen; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 88th Texas Legislature 21 hereby congratulate Colton Thomas of the Wise County Office of 22 Emergency Management on his receipt of a Life Saving Medal and 23 extend to him sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further 24 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
