WHEREAS, Led by Stephen F. Austin under contract with the

Mexican government, prospective landowners first came to the plains

6 of the Colorado River in 1822; the Mexican Imperial Colonization

7 Law of 1823 granted 177 acres to the heads of families for farming

8 and 4,428 acres for raising cattle; and

9 WHEREAS, Wharton County was founded in April of 1846, and its

name commemorates two heroes of the Texas Revolution, brothers

11 William Harris Wharton and John Austin Wharton; the advent of

12 railroads and irrigation brought increased settlement to the area,

13 which remains a center of agricultural, educational, industrial,

14 and medical services for a large region; and

WHEREAS, Today, nearly 42,000 people call the county home;

16 encompassing just over 1,000 square miles of primarily prairie and

timberland, it is divided roughly in half by the Colorado River,

18 which flows through the communities of Wharton and Glen Flora; and

19 WHEREAS, The county seat, Wharton is known for its small-town

20 way of life and its Czech, Danish, and Mexican heritage, as well as

21 for its proximity to both Houston and the Gulf Coast, its excellent

22 schools and championship football teams, and its popular festivals;

23 the area also attracts visitors seeking hunting and outdoor

24 recreation opportunities; the county's other largest towns include
