- 14 sponsors several other events earlier in the year, such as an annual
- 15 costume gala and a kayak fun race; proceeds from the festival go
- 16 toward local nonprofit organizations that support recreation,
- 17 beautification, tourism, and higher education in the area; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Sombrero Festival is organized by an
- 19 all-volunteer board of directors, which benefits from the able
- 20 leadership of its 2023 president, Lupita G. Vera; Ms. Vera became
- 21 the board's treasurer in 2006 and went on to serve the festival as
- 22 vice president of events and vice president of marketing before
- 23 taking on her current role; and
