RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Brad Toben is concluding his remarkable 32-year tenure as dean of Baylor Law School on July 1, 2023, to focus on his work as the M. C. and Mattie Caston Professor of Law; and
WHEREAS, Appointed in 1991, Dean Toben has been acknowledged

5 as the longest-serving dean of a major law school; the average tenure in this demanding role is a mere four years, but Dean Toben 6 has devoted the greater part of his career to the advancement of 7 Baylor Law and legal education; under his leadership, the school 8 has risen to the top 50 in the nation, and it has been ranked No. 2 9 in trial advocacy by U.S. News & World Report; its students have 10 11 regularly achieved a high pass rate on the Texas bar exam, and their success in finding employment has enabled the school to earn 12 outstanding marks for placement; drawn from numerous undergraduate 13 14 institutions, the law school boasts a diverse enrollment; presently, over 30 percent are students of color and over half are 15 16 women; and

WHEREAS, Dean Toben guided the \$35 million building campaign 17 for the Sheila and Walter Umphrey Law Center, and he has raised the 18 Baylor Law endowment from under \$1 million to more than \$180 19 million; committed to maintaining small class sizes and promoting 20 21 mentorship, he expanded the faculty considerably; community-oriented pro bono and public service initiatives he 22 23 developed have won such accolades as the American Bar Association Pro Bono Publico Award; moreover, he strengthened the national 24

- 1 reputation of Baylor's renowned legal writing program and launched
- 2 innovative programs in professional development and leadership, as
- 3 well as exceptional study abroad opportunities; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Over the years, Dean Toben has been active in
- 5 accreditation and membership inspections for the ABA and
- 6 Association of American Law Schools; he was appointed to the
- 7 National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws and
- 8 elected to the American Law Institute, and he is a fellow of the ABA
- 9 and the Texas Bar Foundation as well as a Master of the Bench in the
- 10 Judge Abner V. McCall American Inn of Court; after graduating from
- 11 Baylor Law with honors in 1977, he went on to earn a master of laws
- 12 degree from Harvard University; he taught at Indiana University
- 13 School of Law-Indianapolis before joining the Baylor faculty in
- 14 1981; and
- WHEREAS, A leader of exceptional vision, dynamism, and
- 16 dedication, Brad Toben has made a profound impact on Baylor Law
- 17 School and the Texas legal community, and his legacy will resonate
- 18 for years to come; now, therefore, be it
- 19 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 88th Texas Legislature
- 20 hereby honor Brad Toben for his exceptional service as dean of
- 21 Baylor Law School and extend to him sincere best wishes for
- 22 continued success; and, be it further
