WHEREAS, Through the ongoing support of the Marlin community and its residents, the club has continued to thrive through expanded outreach to engage young adults in its activities; the club's recent projects include the replanting of the Falls County Courthouse rose garden and maintaining the Liberty Bell rose garden and the City Hall garden; and

residents of Marlin and the Lone Star State with lush and vibrant gardens, and all who have contributed to the garden club's success can reflect with pride on its long history of service; now, therefore, be it
