R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Lynn McKinney is retiring as deputy superintendent
2 of the Aledo Independent School District in June 2023, drawing to a
3 close an exceptional career in education that has spanned nearly
4 four and a half decades; and

5 WHEREAS, The district's longest-tenured employee, Lynn
6 McKinney has served as deputy superintendent since 2011; she joined
7 Aledo ISD in 1986 as a first-grade teacher, and she went on to serve
8 as a sixth-grade resource teacher and vice principal at K-3 Aledo
9 Elementary and subsequently as vice principal and as the first
10 female principal of Aledo High School; after leading Aledo High for
11 almost a decade, she was promoted to district assistant
12 superintendent of curriculum and instruction and then to assistant
13 superintendent of special programs, a position she held for 10
14 years before being appointed deputy superintendent; and

15 WHEREAS, Prior to joining Aledo ISD, Mrs. McKinney worked for
16 Teacher Corps, and she taught at Sam Houston High School in Houston
17 and at Campbell Elementary School in Austin; and

18 WHEREAS, Widely respected by her colleagues, Mrs. McKinney
19 was recognized as the Texas Association of Secondary School
20 Principals Region 11 Outstanding Secondary Principal for 1998, and
21 she was one of five state finalists for the TASSP State Secondary
22 Principal of the Year honor; engaged in her community, she received
23 the East Parker County Chamber of Commerce Woman of the Year award
24 in 2000; retirement will afford her the opportunity to spend more

1 time with her family, which includes her husband, Randal, and their
2 two sons; and

3 WHEREAS, By helping countless young Texans acquire the
4 knowledge and skills necessary to succeed, Lynn McKinney has made
5 an immeasurable impact during her 37 years with Aledo ISD, and she
6 may indeed reflect with pride on a career well spent; now,
7 therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 88th Texas Legislature
9 hereby congratulate Lynn McKinney on her retirement as deputy
10 superintendent of the Aledo Independent School District and extend
11 to her sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be

14 Texas Senate.
