R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Through their swift and decisive actions, three
2 Alvin Independent School District employees played a critical role
3 in rescuing individuals from the wreckage of a traffic collision on
4 February 17, 2022; and

5 WHEREAS, Early that morning, Alvin ISD bus driver Tanya Moore
6 and her two passengers, bus monitors Dustin Carrillo and Jesse
7 Neace, drove up to the scene of a major accident on Highway 6;
8 within seconds of their arrival, multiple vehicles involved in the
9 pileup collision had burst into flames; Ms. Moore immediately
10 called for emergency help, while Mr. Carrillo and Mr. Neace left
11 the bus and sprinted toward the pileup; the Alvin ISD employees
12 pulled the victims from the wreckage within 90 seconds, before any
13 professional first responders had arrived; and

14 WHEREAS, In recognition of the courage and heroism they
15 displayed that day, Ms. Moore, Mr. Carrillo, and Mr. Neace were
16 honored by Alvin ISD in an official ceremony; and

17 WHEREAS, Tanya Moore, Dustin Carrillo, and Jesse Neace
18 bravely put themselves in harm's way to save the lives of others,
19 and in so doing, they have distinguished themselves as exemplary
20 members of the Alvin Independent School District and the community
21 at large; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Senate of the 88th Texas Legislature
23 hereby commend Tanya Moore, Dustin Carrillo, and Jesse Neace for
24 their lifesaving actions on February 17, 2022, and extend to them

1 sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further

2 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
3 prepared for Ms. Moore, Mr. Carrillo, and Mr. Neace as an
4 expression of high regard by the Texas Senate.
