R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Dale W. Wilson demonstrated remarkable skill and
2 dedication when he came to the aid of a man suffering from a heart
3 attack on April 17, 2023; and

4 WHEREAS, A registered nurse, Mr. Wilson was off duty and
5 driving on Interstate 35 when he saw a truck swerve and collide with
6 the concrete barrier along the freeway; he quickly pulled over his
7 own vehicle and rushed to the scene of the accident, where he found
8 the driver slumped over in his seat; and

9 WHEREAS, After freeing the driver from the truck, Mr. Wilson
10 began performing CPR as he waited for emergency medical services to
11 arrive; he later learned that his swift action had saved the life of
12 the motorist, who had experienced a heart attack while driving; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson is a mental health nurse and the director
14 of quality management at Austin State Hospital, where he has been
15 employed for more than 15 years; his exceptional skills as a nurse
16 have been instrumental in improving patient outcomes and have
17 earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues; and

18 WHEREAS, In saving the life of a fellow citizen, Dale Wilson
19 drew upon his experience in nursing and demonstrated the
20 compassion, proficiency, and commitment to the well-being of others
21 for which those in his profession are known, and it is indeed
22 fitting that he be honored for his selfless act of heroism; now,
