1 WHEREAS, Dr. Telena Wright is retiring as superintendent of 2 the Argyle Independent School District on June 30, 2023, drawing to a close an outstanding tenure that has spanned more than 15 years; 3 4 and 5 WHEREAS, A native of Ballinger, Dr. Wright began her career in public education as a math teacher in San Angelo ISD, and she 6 7 went on to become an elementary and high school counselor; she joined Argyle ISD as principal of Argyle High School in 2000, and 8 9 three years later, she accepted a position as the district's assistant superintendent; she was named superintendent in 2009; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Dr. Wright has overseen three successful bond 12 programs that have included the addition of new campuses as well as renovations and other improvements to existing campuses; she also 13 14 played an instrumental role in establishing the Argyle ISD Police Department and special education department; since her appointment 15 16 as supervisor, district enrollment has increased from 1,700 to some 5,000 students, and she has guided a team to develop a 10-year 17 growth plan for the district; and 18 WHEREAS, Under Dr. Wright's able leadership, Argyle ISD has 19 received a number of honors, including an A accountability rating 20
