WHEREAS, Mr. Ponton grew up in Alpine; after receiving his bachelor's degree from The University of Texas at Austin in 1973, he went on to graduate from the Texas Tech University School of Law in 1982; and

WHEREAS, Now forever renowned as "the Cat Lawyer," Mr. Ponton appeared in a Zoom call video that went viral in February

2021, when he proclaimed for what would become a global audience, "I'm here live, I'm not a cat," as a wayward filter imposed the image of a kitten over his face; this led to an interview on television's TODAY show and other major media coverage; and

WHEREAS, Through the years, Rod Ponton has demonstrated a deep commitment to the legal profession and to public service, and his accomplishments have earned the admiration and appreciation of his fellow West Texas residents; now, therefore, be it
