1 WHEREAS, Dr. Mark Bronson, owner of the Bronson Clinic in
2 Fort Worth, has received the 2023 Paul M. Tullio Award from the
3 National Board of Chiropractic Examiners; and

4 WHEREAS, Named in honor of Dr. Paul Tullio, a renowned leader
5 in the chiropractic field, the Tullio Award recognizes individuals
6 who have distinguished themselves in any or all of the areas of
7 examination development, administration, analysis, or scoring for
8 the chiropractic profession; and

9 WHEREAS, In addition to operating the Bronson Clinic,
10 Dr. Bronson has served as a designated doctor for the Texas
11 Department of Insurance's Division of Workers' Compensation and as
12 chief examiner for the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners; he
13 has been active in the Texas Chiropractic Association as president
14 of his district, as state director, as a board member, and as
15 coordinator of the organization's Department of Scientific
16 Affairs, and he was honored with its Doctor of the Year award; in
17 2016, he was appointed by Governor Greg Abbott to the Texas Board of
18 Chiropractic Examiners, where he is currently serving his second
19 term; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Bronson holds a bachelor of business
21 administration degree in finance from The University of Texas at
22 Austin and a doctor of chiropractic degree from Texas Chiropractic
23 College; he is a member of the American Chiropractic Association
24 and the Texas Council of Chiropractic Orthopedists, and he holds

1 certifications in chiropractic orthopedics, pain management,
2 disability analysis, and neuromusculoskeletal medicine; and

3 WHEREAS, Mark Bronson has served his patients and his peers
4 with great dedication, and it is a privilege to join in honoring him
5 for his myriad achievements; now, therefore, be it
