## Suspending limitations on conference committee jurisdiction, S.B. No. 10 (Huffman/Bonnen)

## RESOLUTION

- 1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, 88th
- 2 Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, That Senate Rule 12.03 be
- 3 suspended in part as provided by Senate Rule 12.08 to enable the
- 4 conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on Senate
- 5 Bill 10 (certain benefits paid by the Teacher Retirement System of
- 6 Texas) to consider and take action on the following matters:
- 7 (1) Senate Rule 12.03(2) is suspended to permit the
- 8 committee to omit text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 1 of
- 9 the bill, adding Section 824.703(a), Government Code, by striking
- 10 "an additional" and substituting "a".
- 11 Explanation: The change is necessary to remove unnecessary
- 12 language.
- 13 (2) Senate Rules 12.03(3) and (4), are suspended to permit
- 14 the committee to add text on a matter not in disagreement and not
- 15 included in either the house or senate version of the bill in
- 16 proposed SECTION 1 of the bill, by adding Section 824.703(c)(3),
- 17 Government Code, to read as follows:
- 18 (3) is an alternate payee under Section 804.005, to be
- 19 eligible for the adjustment:
- 20 (A) the annuitant must be living on the effective
- 21 date of the adjustment; and
- 22 (B) the effective date of the annuitant's
- 23 election to receive the annuity payment was on or before August 31,
- 24 2020.

- 1 Explanation: The change is necessary to clarify that an
- 2 alternate payee makes the election and specify that an alternate
- 3 payee must be living on the effective date of the cost-of-living
- 4 adjustment required by the proposed bill.
- 5 (3) Senate Rules 12.03(3) and (4), are suspended to permit
- 6 the committee to add text on a matter not in disagreement and not
- 7 included in either the house or senate version of the bill by adding
- 8 proposed SECTION 2(c) of the bill to read as follows:
- 9 (c) The amount of the supplemental payment is equal to:
- 10 (1) \$7,500, if the annuitant is at least 75 years of
- 11 age on any day of the calendar month before the calendar month in
- 12 which the Teacher Retirement System of Texas issues the
- 13 supplemental payment; or
- 14 (2) \$2,400, if the annuitant is:
- 15 (A) at least 70 years of age but younger than 75
- 16 years of age on any day of the calendar month before the calendar
- 17 month in which the Teacher Retirement System of Texas issues the
- 18 supplemental payment; and
- 19 (B) not subject to Subdivision (1) of this
- 20 subsection.
- 21 Explanation: The change is necessary to prescribe different
- 22 amounts for the supplemental payment required by the proposed bill
- 23 based on the age of the annuitant eligible for the payment.
