Brackenridge Elementary School and directed a program promoting conflict resolution at various SAISD campuses; she has taught at the middle and high school levels in other districts as well; deeply dedicated to her community, she has served as the volunteer co-director of the local nonprofit Inner City Development since 1972, and from 2003 to 2007, she was the District 5 representative on the San Antonio City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Radle holds a degree in theology from Marquette University and a degree in English, as well as her teacher and bilingual certifications, from Our Lady of the Lake University; she was recently presented with an honorary doctorate from the Oblate School of Theology; and

**WHEREAS**, Through her dedication, professionalism, and commitment to excellence, Patti Radle has earned the lasting respect and appreciation of her fellow citizens, and her contributions to public education in San Antonio will continue to resonate for years to come; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 88th Legislature, hereby commend Patti Radle for her years of service to the San Antonio Independent School District Board of Trustees and extend to her sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further
