A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to define certain terms for purposes of the exemption from ad
- 3 valorem taxation of farm products in the hands of the producer.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 19, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 19. (a) Farm products[, livestock, and poultry] in the
- 8 hands of the producer $[\tau]$ and family supplies for home and farm
- 9 use $[\tau]$ are exempt from all taxation until otherwise directed by a
- 10 two-thirds vote of all the members elected [elect] to both houses of
- 11 the Legislature.
- 12 (b) The Legislature by general law may define "farm
- 13 products" and "in the hands of the producer" for purposes of this
- 14 section and may include in the definition of "farm products"
- 15 livestock, poultry, timber, and supplies used or produced in a
- 16 farming operation.
- 17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held May 2, 2026. The
- 19 ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 21 legislature to define certain terms for purposes of the exemption
- 22 from ad valorem taxation of farm products in the hands of the
- 23 producer."
