R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Family and friends suffered an immeasurable loss
2 with the tragic passing of Ava Renee Moore on May 25, 2025, at the
3 age of 18; and

4 WHEREAS, The daughter of Tamara and Robert Moore, Ava Moore
5 was born on September 14, 2006, and she grew up with the
6 companionship of her brother, Robert; she graduated with the Class
7 of 2024 from Timber Creek High School in Fort Worth, where she
8 excelled academically and was captain of the basketball team as
9 well as a member of the varsity golf team; and

10 WHEREAS, At the time of her passing, Ms. Moore had just
11 completed her first year at the U.S. Air Force Academy Preparatory
12 School in Colorado Springs, Colorado, and she was planning on
13 reentering the academy as a cadet with the Class of 2029; moreover,
14 she had continued her athletic career as a standout player on the
15 prep school women's basketball team, helping the squad to compile
16 an undefeated record; and

17 WHEREAS, Ms. Moore demonstrated a strong affinity for
18 linguistics, gaining competency in Korean, and she was considering
19 undertaking studies in Chinese; her many other interests included
20 art, music, literature, and politics and foreign relations; witty,
21 determined, and deeply curious about the world around her, she
22 distinguished herself as an inspiring mentor to her peers and was
23 known for her kindness and humility; in recognition of the positive
24 influence she had on the Timber Creek High School community, the

1 school is paying tribute to her memory on November 7, 2025, by
2 retiring her jersey number and establishing a scholarship fund in
3 her honor; and

4 WHEREAS, No words can diminish the pain caused by a life cut
5 short, but all who shared in the love and friendship of Ava Moore
6 may find comfort in their treasured memories of this exceptional
7 young woman; now, therefore, be it

10 of Ava Renee Moore and extend deepest condolences to the members of
