11	Veterans Commission deidentified information on the person's:
12	(1) manner of death, only if the death was by suicide
13	or homicide;
14	(2) age;
15	(3) race;
16	(4) previous use of psychotropic drugs;
17	(5) sex; and
18	(6) occupation.
19	(e) Not later than September 1 of each year, the Texas
20	Veterans Commission shall prepare and submit to the standing
21	committees of the legislature with primary jurisdiction over
22	veterans affairs and publish on the commission's Internet website a
23	written report that contains:
24	(1) aggregated data based on the information the

- 1 commission receives under Subsection (d) for the preceding year;
- 2 (2) an evaluation of that data; and
- 3 (3) any recommendations for legislative or other
- 4 <u>action</u>.
- 5 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2027, the Texas
- 6 Veterans Commission shall prepare and submit the initial report
- 7 required by Section 193.006(e), Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 8 this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
