A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the treatment and beneficial use of fluid oil and gas

3 waste and related material, including a limitation on liability for

4 that treatment or use.

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5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 122.003, Natural Resources Code, is

7 amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 122.003. RESPONSIBILITY IN TORT. (a) Except as

provided by Subsection (b), a person who takes possession of fluid

10 oil and gas waste for treatment, produces from that waste $\left[\frac{a}{a}\right]$

11 treated \underline{waste} [product generally considered in the oil and gas

12 industry to be suitable for use in connection with the drilling for

13 or production of oil or gas], and either puts the treated waste to a

beneficial use or transfers the treated waste [product] to another

15 person with the contractual understanding that the treated waste

16 [product] will be put to a beneficial use [used in connection with

17 the drilling for or production of oil or gas] is not liable in tort

18 for a consequence of the subsequent use of that treated $\underline{\text{waste}}$

19 [product] by any [the person to whom the treated product is

20 transferred or by another] person.

21 (a-1) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person,

22 <u>including an owner of the surface estate of real property, who</u>

23 produces fluid oil and gas waste or who supplies or conveys fluid

24 oil and gas waste to a treatment facility for the purpose of

- 1 generating treated waste is not liable in tort for:
- 2 (1) a consequence of the subsequent treatment of that
- 3 fluid oil and gas waste to generate treated waste;
- 4 (2) the subsequent use of that treated waste by any
- 5 person; or
- 6 (3) exposure to any component of the waste or any
- 7 byproduct of the process used to generate treated waste.
- 8 (a-2) Except as provided by Subsection (b), an owner of the
- 9 surface estate of real property on or under which fluid oil and gas
- 10 waste is produced, conveyed, or transported is not liable in an
- 11 action for damages for personal injury, death, or property damage
- 12 arising from exposure to fluid oil and gas waste, treated waste, or
- 13 a byproduct of a process used to generate treated waste.
- 14 (b) This section does not affect the liability of a person
- 15 [that treats fluid oil and gas waste for beneficial use] in an
- 16 action brought by a <u>claimant</u> [person] for damages for personal
- 17 injury, death, or property damage arising from exposure to fluid
- 18 oil and gas waste, treated waste, or a byproduct of a process used
- 19 to generate treated waste if that exposure occurred as a result of
- 20 the person's:
- 21 (1) gross negligence or intentional, wrongful act or
- 22 <u>omission; or</u>
- (2) negligence and the person did not treat, generate,
- 24 use, or dispose of the fluid oil and gas waste, treated waste, or
- 25 byproduct in conformity with:
- 26 (A) rules adopted under Section 122.004; or
- 27 (B) a Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination

- 1 System program permit issued by the Texas Commission on
- 2 Environmental Quality under Section 26.027 or 26.131, Water Code
- 3 [product].
- 4 (c) A claimant awarded damages for a tort premised solely on
- 5 the person's negligence and regulatory nonconformity under
- 6 Subsection (b)(2) may not be awarded exemplary damages.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 122.004(a), Natural Resources Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) The commission shall adopt rules to govern the treatment
- 10 and beneficial use of <u>fluid</u> oil and gas waste, treated waste, and
- 11 any byproduct of a process used to generate treated waste.
- 12 SECTION 3. Chapter 122, Natural Resources Code, as amended
- 13 by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or
- 14 after the effective date of this Act. A cause of action that
- 15 accrues before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 16 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 17 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
