A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to fluid oil and gas waste and products and byproducts of
- 3 that waste.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 122.001, Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:
- 7 (3) "Treated product" means the product of a process
- 8 that treats, filters, refines, extracts, or otherwise alters any
- 9 portion or component of fluid oil and gas waste to render it
- 10 suitable for a beneficial use.
- 11 SECTION 2. Sections 122.002 and 122.003, Natural Resources
- 12 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 122.002. OWNERSHIP OF FLUID OIL AND GAS WASTE
- 14 TRANSFERRED FOR TREATMENT AND SUBSEQUENT BENEFICIAL USE. Unless
- 15 otherwise expressly provided by an oil or gas lease, a surface use
- 16 agreement, a contract, a bill of sale, or another legally binding
- 17 document:
- 18 (1) when fluid oil and gas waste is produced and used
- 19 by or transferred to a person who takes possession of that waste for
- 20 the purpose of generating treated product [treating the waste for a
- 21 subsequent beneficial use], the waste is considered to be the
- 22 property of the person who takes possession of it for the purpose of
- 23 generating the treated product [treating the waste for subsequent
- 24 beneficial use] until the person transfers the waste or treated

- 1 product [waste] to another person for disposal or use; and
- 2 (2) when a person who takes possession of fluid oil and
- 3 gas waste for the purpose of generating treated product [treating
- 4 the waste for a subsequent beneficial use] transfers possession of
- 5 the treated product or any [treatment] byproduct of the process
- 6 that generated the treated product to another person for the
- 7 purpose of subsequent disposal or beneficial use, the transferred
- 8 product or byproduct is considered to be the property of the person
- 9 to whom the material is transferred.
- 10 Sec. 122.003. RESPONSIBILITY IN TORT. (a) Except as
- 11 provided by Subsection (b), a person who takes possession of fluid
- 12 oil and gas waste, produces from that waste a treated product
- 13 [generally considered in the oil and gas industry to be suitable for
- 14 use in connection with the drilling for or production of oil or
- 15 gas], and either puts the treated product to a beneficial use or
- 16 transfers the treated product to another person with the
- 17 contractual understanding that the treated product will be put to a
- 18 beneficial use [used in connection with the drilling for or
- 19 production of oil or gas] is not liable in tort for a consequence of
- 20 the subsequent use of that treated product by any [the person to
- 21 whom the treated product is transferred or by another] person.
- 22 (a-1) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person who
- 23 produces fluid oil and gas waste or who supplies or conveys fluid
- 24 oil and gas waste to a treatment facility for the purpose of
- 25 generating a treated product is not liable in tort for:
- 26 (1) a consequence of the subsequent treatment of that
- 27 fluid oil and gas waste to generate treated product;

- 1 (2) the subsequent use of that treated product by any
- 2 person; or
- 3 (3) exposure to a byproduct of the process used to
- 4 generate treated product.
- 5 (b) This section does not affect the liability of a person
- 6 [that treats fluid oil and gas waste for beneficial use] in an
- 7 action brought by a <u>claimant</u> [person] for damages for personal
- 8 injury, death, or property damage arising from exposure to fluid
- 9 oil and gas waste, a treated product, or a byproduct of a process
- 10 <u>used to generate</u> treated product <u>if that exposure occurred as a</u>
- 11 result of the person's:
- 12 (1) gross negligence or intentional, wrongful act or
- 13 omission; or
- 14 (2) negligence and the person did not treat, generate,
- 15 use, or dispose of the fluid oil and gas waste, treated product, or
- 16 byproduct in conformity with:
- 17 (A) rules adopted under Section 122.004; or
- 18 (B) a Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination
- 19 System program permit issued by the Texas Commission on
- 20 Environmental Quality under Section 26.027 or 26.131, Water Code.
- 21 <u>(c)</u> A claimant awarded damages for a tort premised solely on
- 22 the person's negligence and regulatory nonconformity under
- 23 Subsection (b)(2) may not be awarded exemplary damages.
- SECTION 3. Section 122.004(a), Natural Resources Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- 26 (a) The commission shall adopt rules to govern the treatment
- 27 and beneficial use of fluid oil and gas waste, treated product, and

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- 1 any byproduct of a process used to generate treated product.
- 2 SECTION 4. Chapter 122, Natural Resources Code, as amended
- 3 by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or
- 4 after the effective date of this Act. A cause of action that
- 5 accrues before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 6 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 7 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
