14	(1) enrolled and in good standing in a Reserve
15	Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) program;
16	(2) members in good standing in a corps of cadets,
17	including a corps of cadets at a senior military college; or
18	(3) enrolled and in good standing in a maritime
19	academy.
20	(c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, in
21	consultation with institutions of higher education, shall adopt
22	rules as necessary to implement and administer this section.
23	SECTION 2. Section 51.9835, Education Code, as added by
24	this Act, applies beginning with registration for a course or
