- 12 institution shall provide early registration for those courses or

- 14 (1) enrolled and in good standing in a Reserve
- 15 Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) program;
- 16 (2) members in good standing in a corps of cadets,
- 17 including a corps of cadets at a senior military college; or
- 18 (3) enrolled and in good standing in a maritime
- 19 <u>academy.</u>
- (c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, in
- 21 consultation with institutions of higher education, shall adopt
- 22 rules as necessary to implement and administer this section.
- SECTION 2. Section 51.9835, Education Code, as added by
- 24 this Act, applies beginning with registration for a course or
