A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 554.001(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The department shall <u>designate state facilities for</u> use
- 8 [the Waco Center for Youth] as [a] residential treatment facilities
- 9 [facility] for emotionally disturbed juveniles who:
- 10 (1) have been admitted under Subtitle C to a facility
- 11 of the department; or
- 12 (2) are under the managing conservatorship of the
- 13 Department of Family and Protective Services and have been admitted
- 14 under Subtitle C to a state facility designated by the department
- 15 <u>under this section</u> [the Waco Center for Youth].
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 554.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 554.002. SERVICES. (a) The department shall provide
- 19 without charge appropriate education services for all clients
- 20 residing at state facilities designated by the department under
- 21 Section 554.001 [the Waco Center for Youth].
- 22 (b) The department shall pay for the [those] services
- 23 described by Subsection (a) from funds appropriated [to the center]
- 24 for that purpose.

- 1 (c) A client of <u>a state facility designated by the</u>
 2 <u>department under Section 554.001</u> [the center] who is not a resident
 3 of the <u>school district that serves the geographical area in which</u>
 4 <u>the facility is located</u> [Waco Independent School District] may
 5 receive education services from the <u>district</u> [Waco Independent
 6 School District] only with the prior approval of the superintendent
 7 of the district.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
