- 8 (c) If the legislature appropriates money to the commission
- 9 for the purpose of the construction, expansion, or operation of
- 10 certain inpatient mental health facilities under authority
- 11 conferred by Sections 2155.144(b-2) and 2166.251, Government Code,
- 12 the commission may award the money as a one-time grant directly to
- 13 <u>an entity for that purpose.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 554.001(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) The department shall <u>designate state facilities for</u> use
- 17 [the Waco Center for Youth] as [a] residential treatment facilities
- 18 [facility] for emotionally disturbed juveniles who:
- 19 (1) have been admitted under Subtitle C to a facility
- 20 of the department; or
- 21 (2) are under the managing conservatorship of the
- 22 Department of Family and Protective Services and have been admitted
- 23 under Subtitle C to a state facility designated by the department
- 24 under this section [the Waco Center for Youth].

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 554.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 554.002. SERVICES. (a) The department shall provide
- 4 without charge appropriate education services for all clients
- 5 residing at state facilities designated by the department under
- 6 Section 554.001 [the Waco Center for Youth].
- 7 (b) The department shall pay for  $\underline{\text{the}}$  [those] services
- 8 <u>described by Subsection (a)</u> from funds appropriated [to the center]
- 9 for that purpose.
- 10 (c) A client of a state facility designated by the
- 11 <u>department under Section 554.001</u> [the center] who is not a resident
- 12 of the school district that serves the geographical area in which
- 13 the facility is located [Waco Independent School District] may
- 14 receive education services from the district [Waco Independent
- 15 School District] only with the prior approval of the superintendent
- 16 of the district.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
