## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to state centers and homes.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 554.001, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 554.001. ADMISSION OF CERTAIN JUVENILES. (a) The
- 7 department shall <u>designate facilities for</u> use [the Waco Center for
- 8  $\frac{\text{Youth}}{\text{I}}$  as  $\frac{1}{\text{A}}$  residential treatment  $\frac{\text{facility}}{\text{I}}$  for
- 9 emotionally disturbed juveniles who:
- 10 (1) have been admitted under Subtitle C to a facility
- 11 of the department; or
- 12 (2) are under the managing conservatorship of the
- 13 Department of Family and Protective Services and have been admitted
- 14 under Subtitle C to the designated facilities [Waco Center for
- 15 Youth].
- 16 (b) An emotionally disturbed juvenile who has been found to
- 17 have engaged in delinquent conduct or conduct indicating a need for
- 18 supervision under Title 3, Family Code, may not be admitted to the
- 19 designated facilities [Waco Center for Youth].
- SECTION 2. Section 554.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 21 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 554.002. SERVICES. (a) The department shall provide
- 23 without charge appropriate education services for all clients
- 24 residing at the designated facilities [Waco Center for Youth].

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- 1 (b) The department shall pay for those services from funds 2 appropriated to the <u>designated facilities</u> [<del>center</del>] for <u>those</u> 3 <u>purposes</u> [<del>that purpose</del>].
- (c) A client of the center who is not a resident of the <u>local</u>

  <u>school district</u> [Waco Independent School District] may receive

  education services from the <u>local school district</u> [Waco Independent

  School District] only with the prior approval of the superintendent

  of the district.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
