- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 26.17, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) This subsection applies only to property that is
- 8 located in one or more school districts that have a local revenue
- 9 level in excess of entitlement as specified by Section 48.257,
- 10 Education Code, and that, for the school year beginning in the
- 11 current tax year, have taken measures to reduce the district's
- 12 local revenue level in accordance with Section 49.002, Education
- 13 Code. In addition to the information required by Subsection (b) of
- 14 this section, the database must include, with respect to each
- 15 property to which this subsection applies that is listed on the
- 16 appraisal roll for the appraisal district, the following
- 17 information, if applicable, for each school district in which the
- 18 property is located:
- 19 <u>(1) the estimated percentage of the taxes for</u>
- 20 <u>maintenance and operations imposed by the district for the current</u>
- 21 tax year that the district is required to pay under the agreement
- 22 for the school year beginning in the current tax year to purchase
- 23 average daily attendance credits;
- 24 (2) the estimated percentage of the taxes for

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- 1 maintenance and operations imposed by the district for the current
- 2 tax year that the district is not required to pay under the
- 3 agreement for the school year beginning in the current tax year to
- 4 purchase average daily attendance credits; and
- 5 (3) the following statement:
- 6 "For the current tax year, (name of school district) is
- 7 <u>estimated to pay (percentage described by Subdivision (1) for</u>
- 8 applicable school district) of local property tax collections to
- 9 the state as recaptured local taxes and (percentage described by
- 10 Subdivision (2) for applicable school district) is estimated to
- 11 remain in (name of school district) for the maintenance and
- 12 operations of the district.".
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2026.
